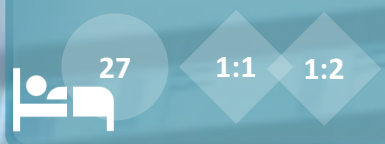

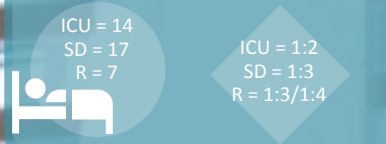

CARDIOVASCULAR INTENSIVE CARE (CVICU)

Patients who have sustained major trauma to their body including traumatic head, neck, spinal cord, abdominal and orthopedic injuries, penetrating trauma or vehicle accident injuries.

Diverse, critically ill patients from multiple surgical services who may be experiencing multisystem organ dysfunction, sepsis, or other critical care issues.

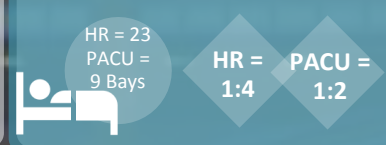
