**Where to come:**

**Outpatient OT and PT students and Preschool OT students** will come to the outpatient clinic on their first morning at 8:00 and ask the front desk to notify Debbie Scott, our rehab tech that you are here. The outpatient clinic is located at the below address and just inside Entrance G, which is at the back of the building on the end closest to the Guitar Center. There is a parking lot just outside Entrance G that you can park in on this first day.

**Acute Care OT and PT students** will come to the Children's Hospital on their first morning at 8:30 and report to the therapy office located on the 8<sup>th</sup> floor. When you get to the lobby on the 8th floor, there is a phone where you can call 6-0730. Or if there is someone there to let you in, you can come down the center hallway and we are the first door on the left, room 8006. The hospital is located at the below address and you can park in the West garage at the 25th avenue entrance, there are numbered spaces. The west garage is on the corner of 25th and Children's Ave.

**What to expect on your first day:**

During the morning Debbie Scott, rehab tech, will take you to get your ID badge and parking pass (remember to bring vehicle registration, driver's license, and check for parking). Your clinical instructor will set you up on a computer to activate your access codes and complete online orientation training. In addition as time allows, your CI will provide a tour of the facility, introduce you to staff, and have you begin to observe treatments.
